2011 TEAM RULES AND COMMITMENT AGREEMENT**

PARENTS AND PLAYER COMMITMENT AGREEMENT:

Kishwaukee Valley Storm Travel Teams will require a very high level of commitment. Girls will be expected to attend practice on a regular basis and participate in regularly scheduled games. **Tournaments are an integral part of this program and girls are required to attend.** This is a commitment made not only by the girl, but the parents as well, because it is your responsibility to see that your daughter is present. **If you are unable to make this type of commitment, your daughter should not participate in these tryouts.** Your signatures below confirm your willingness to comply to this type of commitment as well as adhere to the team rules listed below, should you be offered and accept a position with the Kishwaukee Valley Storm Softball Organization for the 2011 season.

1. Attend, ready to play (with all equipment needed), all games and practices on time.
2. If a player will miss a game or practice, the player/parent must notify the manager ahead of time.
3. A positive attitude and team chemistry are critical to the success of our program.
4. **Players, parents and the coaching staff will represent Kishwaukee Valley Storm Fastpitch Softball in a professional manner with a high degree of sportsmanship and respect at games and tournaments.**
5. All players are responsible for the care and maintenance of both the team's and their personal softball equipment. This includes assisting the manager in getting the equipment to and from fields.
6. Players are recommended to improve their softball skills by attending camps and clinics during the off-season. Parents/Guardians must make sure that their daughter's physical health is approved by a doctor for highly competitive softball.
7. The manager will determine which, where and when players will play in practice and tournament games. Positions and playing time are **NOT** guaranteed at any time.
8. Players/parents wishing to discuss an individual situation may approach the manager after practices or at another time. Their situations will **NOT** be discussed prior to or during a game/practice or immediately following a game. There is a minimum 24 hour "cooling off" period for such discussions.
9. Mandatory participation in all Kishwaukee Valley Storm Fastpitch Softball fund-raisers and all registration monies are to be paid in full prior to participating in any Kishwaukee Valley Storm practice or game.
10. No use of tobacco products, illegal or non-approved drugs or alcohol. Use of these items will result in suspension.
11. The coaching staff may add additional rules as they feel are necessary for their individual team.
12. **All players and their parents or guardians accept all risk, including but not limited to injury, associated with playing on the Kishwaukee Valley Storm Fastpitch Softball Team at this level. The players and their parents or guardians are aware of all these risks. The players and their parents/guardians agree that the coaches and other members of Kishwaukee Valley Storm Fastpitch Softball Club will not be liable for anything resulting from participation with the Kishwaukee Valley Storm Fastpitch Softball Club Team at these try-outs or during the 2010-2011 tournament season.**
